



## Thanks for the help!

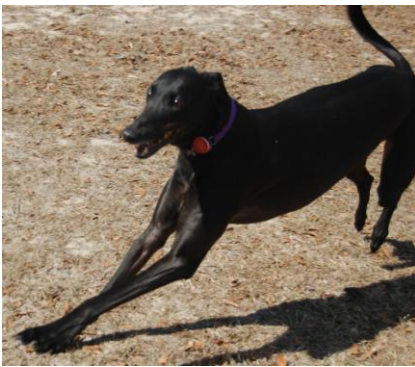
